This conference will equip the land user with the latest information on how to build soil tilth, reducing nutrient and chemical inputs thus increasing productivity and profitability.

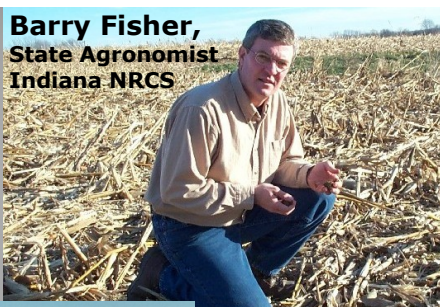
