Additional information on each of the items of special equipment is on file at *Two-Cylinder* and can be supplied, at no charge, to verified owners of Model "AI" tractors. Also available is a listing of original factory equipment which provides a limited amount of information about how each of the tractors was equipped when it left the factory. Most of the tractors were built reflecting the description in Decision No. 6100, but that wasn't always the case. Some had special wheel and tire equipment, a different gear ratio, no fenders, a double PTO or other equipment which sets them apart from regular "AI's".

To obtain additional information on a specific "AI", the owner should write to *Two-Cylinder* and provide the serial number and a photograph of each side and the rear of the tractor, as it will help to identify specific equipment.
