AgGPS FmX Integrated Display: Resetting Display Defaults

This support note explains how to reset and then restore the display defaults on the Trimble[®] $AgGPS^{®}$ FmXTM integrated display.

Once you have set up the FmX integrated display, Trimble recommends that you save all settings. If you save your settings, you can restore them.

There are two reset options:

- Soft reset (using the on-screen menu). This does not lock the functions; and only resets a few configuration values.
- Hard reset (hold down both Brightness buttons). Locks previously unlocked advanced functionality.

Note: To unlock any Setup or Calibrate button marked with a padlock icon 1, enter the administrative password 2009.

Soft reset

Use this reset if the display is turned on.

- 1. Tap the Configuration icon 🔀
- 2. Select *System* and then tap **Setup**.
- 3. Select *Settings* at the bottom of the list and then tap **Default**.
- 4. In the *Are you sure you want to restore your default settings?* dialog, tap **Yes**. The display shuts down.
- 5. Restart the display and then reconfigure it. Do one of the following:
 - a. If the configuration was saved previously:

In the System Settings screen, tap Restore.

In the Are you sure you want to restore saved settings? dialog, tap Yes. The display shuts down.

Restart the display after it as completed the reset cycle.

b. If the configuration was not saved previously, reset the following:

Plugins – these are reset so that the Autopilot plugin only is listed. Time zone Receiver – this is reset to *Autonomous* Keyboard

Hard reset

Use this option if you cannot access the Display Defaults reset option from the on-screen menu.

Do not use a hard reset to resolve problems unless this is absolutely necessary, or unless you are advised to do so by Technical Support.

A hard reset locks previously unlocked advanced functions—to unlock them see the final step in the procedure below.

- 1. Turn the display off. Do one of the following:
 - Press the **Shutdown** button.
 - If required: Press and hold the **Power** button until the screen turns off. If the backlight does not turn off, disconnect the power from the display until the backlight turns off.
- 2. Press and hold both brightness keys.
- 3. Tap the **Power** button and continue to hold down both brightness keys until the Home screen appears. This takes approximately 60 seconds.
- 4. Press **OK** to acknowledge the *Receiver Reset* message.
- 5. Reconfigure the display. Do one of the following:
 - a. If the configuration was saved previously:

In the System Settings screen, tap **Restore**.

Restart the display after it as completed the reset cycle.

b. If the configuration was not saved previously, reset the following:

Plugins – these are reset so that the Autopilot plugin only is listed.

Time zone

Receiver – this is reset to Autonomous

Keyboard

c. If required, use the USB or the Manual Entry method to unlock the required Advanced Functions. For more information, see the *AgGPS FmX User Guide*, Chapter 4, Overview of Plugins.
